- We will only email, chat to, or go on webcam with people that we know in real life, with permission from our teachers or parents.
- We never open emails or links from people we don't know.
- We know that the rules are there to keep us safe and must not be broken.
- We know to think critically when reading information online - not everything we see and read online is accurate or true.
