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#### Year R/1 - Phoenix

I cannot believe we are already in the Summer term. This year is certainly flying by and what a great start to the term R/1 have had.

Following the children's fantastic forest school sessions, Year 1 have been working hard on writing a recount of their sessions in English. Reception children have been working really hard on writing sentences to describe characters and settings in a story. In Maths, Year 1 have been enjoying exploring mass and volume to start the term and Reception are continuing their number work with numbers to 20.

In Science this term, the children are learning all about animals. To help bring this topic to life, the children had an exciting delivery last week. They will be looking after their own caterpillars and tadpoles! The children have been mesmerised so far and are very excited to watch the life cycle of these two animals.

#### Year 2 - Dragon

We have had a great start to term 5 and have been particularly loving our new class book "The Marvellous Fluffy Itty Bitty".

In reading, we have enjoyed reading the flower book and seeing how the setting changed overtime. We have then been visualising and designing a new city for our character Brigg which is full of flowers and colour. In Maths, we have been working on fractions and have worked on finding half, a quarter and a third of an amount. In Science, we are learning all about plants and have enjoyed observing seeds and bulbs, as well as planting our own bulbs. We look forward to observing their changes overtime. In history, our focus is explorers. So far, we have looked at chronology and how the time in which Christopher Columbus was alive is different to modern times.

In computing, we have shown great partnership and friendship as we have helped one another to make renditions of twinkle twinkle little star using the music software on purple mash. In PSHE, we have been looking at families and relationships and what makes our family so unique and special. In RE, we are looking at the good news Jesus brings, and we have been reflecting upon how these stories show our school values. Keep up the fabulous work dragons! You are all superstars.

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Year 3/4 - Centaur

It has as always been another busy few weeks in Centaur class. In English, we have now begun our new unit of writing based on the book "Secrets of a Sun King". It is a book based upon the life of King Tutankhamun and follows the life of him and his best friend, Maya. We will be following their adventures and writing a diary entry from the point of view of Maya, as King Tut faces many challenges while being Pharaoh. We have taken many lessons exploring these characters through role play and drama and are now ready to write! In Science, we are well into our unit on plants, and what they need in order to grow well. We have learned about the functions of the different parts of a plant, and are going to be investigating whether the type of soil has an impact on how well a plant grows and remains healthy. In History, we have begun our learning on Ancient Egypt, and have started by exploring what an "ancient civilisation" actually is and have researched some major ones that existed around the world.

Well done Centaur class - we have lots more to learn over the coming weeks, including Mayday dances to get practising! Keep up the superb work!!



Year 5/6 - Griffin

Griffin class have been working incredibly hard over the last couple of weeks in preparation for the Year 6 SATs.

We have revised different word classes in Grammar and used previous papers to practice strategies for answering comprehension questions.

In Maths, Year 6 have been working on identifying angles in shapes, measuring and drawing angles and co-ordinates.
